Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.85, dated 8.11.2018, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (offence under Section 307 IPC added later on), at Police Station Harike , District Tarn Taran.

Although the petitioner is in custody since November 2018, however, allegation against the petitioner are that he used a sharp edge sword type weapon which went through the thigh of the injured and his leg had to be amputated.
