Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent No.4 for which the petitioner is stated to have submitted a representation dated 20.04.2019 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga.

Perusal of the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-2) shows that there is matrimonial discord between the petitioner and respondent No.4 and proceedings under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for dissolution of marriage by way of divorce is pending before the family Court, Moga for 31.05.2019.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, but considering the prayer of the petitioner for protection of her life and liberty, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation (Annexure P-2) so far as the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner is concerned.
