Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.4 dated 14.03.2019 under Section 7 of the P.C. Act, 1988, registered at Vigilance Bureau, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner had no role for sanctioning of the mutation and no money was received by him.

Learned State counsel contended that there are specific allegations that the petitioner had received a sum of Rs.30,000/- as a bribe money and he was posted as Patwari at the relevant time and, as such, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that there are specific allegations of accepting the bribe money, no case is made out for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner and the present petition is dismissed.
