Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of complaint No.309-II dated 19.4.2010/ 03.4.2010 (Annexure P-3), under Section 18(a)(i) read with Sections 17-A, 17-B, 17 and 16 of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners invites the attention of the Court to the order dated 07.5.2018, to highlight the ground noticed by this Court for quashing the complaint (Annexure P-3) for offences under Sections 18(a)(i) read with Sections 17-A, 17-B, 17 and 16 of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, i.e. lack jurisdiction, as the same is triable by Special Court (Sessions Court). It is apprised that the proceedings have already

been transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction i.e. Special Court and the trial is in progress.

According to learned senior counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
