KULDIP SINGH, J.

Petitioner present in person states that after the death of his wife his in-laws had forcibly taken away his minor daughter with themselves. He has filed a petition under Section 12 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 in the year 2018 for custody of the child. He further contends that considering the fact that the future of the minor is involved, expeditious disposal of the petition should be ordered.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that it is a case of custody of the minor daughter and should be otherwise decided expeditiously, the petition is disposed of reminding the Guardian Judge, Rupnagar that such petitions are to be disposed of expeditiously without granting adjournments.

It is further directed that the case shall be tried by learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rupnagar (Guardian Judge) himself and if it has been transferred to some other Court for one or the other reason, it will stand transferred to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rupnagar (Guardian Judge).
