The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 105 dated 24.08.2014, under Sections 324, 323, 355, 326, 295-A, 379, 148 and 149 of the IPC read with Sections 3 and 4 of the SC/ST Act (added later on), registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the course of investigation, the petitioner was found to be innocent and he has also joined the investigation.

In reply, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh, submits that petitioner has joined investigation and challan against three of co-accused, namely Balkar Singh, Saba and William Masih, has already been presented and one other co-accused namely Kaka was arrested later on and challan against this accused was also presented.

On instructions, learned State counsel has further submitted that petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 17.11.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
