Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5 as they have solemnized marriage on 23.04.2019 against the wishes of private respondent.

On 08.05.2019, State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat.

Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that statements of petitioners and respondent Nos.4 and 5 have been recorded wherein it is stated by petitioners that they do not want protection as they are living happily whereas statements of private respondents reveals that they have no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners. Copy of the statements supplied to counsel for the petitioners. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
