On 26.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Shivani Devi and Sunil Kumar, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 and 5. They have placed on record photographs Annexures P-5 to P-8 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 14.03.2019, Annexure P-9 to respondent No.2.

Mr. Kuldeep Tiwari, DAG, Haryana, appearing for the State of Haryana is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 07.05.2019.”

Counsel appearing for the State of Haryana, on instructions from HC Jasmer Singh, has submitted that the statement of Parmod Kumar-respondent No.4 has been recorded who has accepted the marriage and has assured that he would not cause any harm to the petitioners and also would not interfere in their married life.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are not in touch with him.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file a fresh petition, if in future, there is any threat to their life and liberty.
