The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.72 dated 16.07.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 and 377 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga.

The aforesaid FIR was got registered at the instance of the wife of the petitioner. Vide order dated October 03, 2018, this Court while granting interim bail to the petitioner had directed the petitioner as well as the complainant to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Pursuant thereof, the parties appeared before the aforesaid Centre and their joint statement has been recorded on 30.11.2018, which is made part of the record. As per the report of Mediator, the mediation is successful.

In view of the fact that the matter has been settled between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated October 03, 2018 is made absolute. The petitioner shall adhere to the terms of settlement arrived at between the parties in letter and spirit.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
