Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.259 dated 28.02.2019 registered under Sections 452, 427, 506, 34 IPC (Section 379 IPC has been deleted) at P.S. City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that earlier Section 379 IPC was also invoked but the same has been deleted and no action was taken about the alleged injuries caused 2-3 days ago.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from HC Ajay Kumar has accepted that now Section 379 IPC has been deleted.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the

concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 20.05.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required. In case the petitioner does not appear before the investigating officer in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
