Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.6 & 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-6) wherein her year of birth is mentioned as 1998 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-7) depicting his date of birth as 12.03.1995. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural Amritsar, District Amritsar and Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Notice of motion only qua respondents No.1 to 5.

Petitioners appearing in person state that they will supply the copy of the paper book in the office of the Advocate General, Punjab.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and certifying the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
