The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has produced the affidavit of respondent No.4-Pawan Kumar (father of petitioner No.1) to contend that the girl (petitioner No.1) was taken away by respondent No.4 on the pretext of performing her marriage as per the rituals. According to him, still nothing has been done by the father of petitioner No.1 and the petitioner

No.1 is presently residing with her father.

In view of this position, the relief claimed in the petition is rendered infructuous and the petitioner No.2 has the alternative remedy in law to seek company of his wife.

Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the petition to enable petitioner No.2-Rachhpal Kumar to avail alternative remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
