Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Makhan Singh, Police Station Women Bathinda, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana submits that in consequence of interim order dated 12.09.2018, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute though on behalf of the complainant Mr. D.S. Randhawa, Advocate has sought to strongly oppose the stand of the State on the grounds that certain blank cheques of the complainant are in possession of the petitioner who has also illegally retained the passport and other important documents of the complainant.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.09.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section

173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
