This order shall dispose of two petitions i.e. ***CRM-M-39901-2018*** titled as ***Rajiv Malhotra and others Versus Gian Singh and others*** and ***CRM-M-42998-2018*** titled as ***Naresh Singh and others Versus Gian Singh and others***.

Prayer in both these petitions filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to quash the complaint No.COMP-95-2014 titled as “Gian Singh and others Gurdeep Singh and others” as well as the orders dated 31.08.2018 (in CRM-M-39901-2018) and dated 21.09.2018 (in CRM-M-42998-2018) whereby the petitioners have been summoned to face trial.

Counsel for the petitioners has produced a typed copy of order dated 30.03.2019 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class whereby on the basis of statement of respondents No.1 and 2 that they do not want to proceed with the complaint, the complaint has been dismissed as withdrawn. She states that in view of the statement so made by respondents No.1 and 2, the accused and their surety bonds have been discharged in the case and as the complainant has withdrawn the very complaint, the present petitions no more survive and are rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, these petitions are disposed of as infructuous.
