This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to take appropriate action to stop illegal construction of buildings in Zone 'C' Block 29 of the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana and act upon representation dated 17.10.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to consider and decide the application/ representation dated 17.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to him in the Court.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to consider and decide the application/ representation dated 17.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
