This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.31 dated 23.03.2011 registered under Sections 420/406/307 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983 at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has satisfied the complainants who are present in Court. He further states that the co-accused has been acquitted.

Ms. Kamna Thakur, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the complainants-respondents No.2 & 3. Both the complainants are here as identified by their counsel and the Investigating Officer and they have accepted that the payment has been made.

Learned State counsel however points out that in this case the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender as far back in the year 2011 and this dis-entitles him for anticipatory bail.

I find merit in this argument but I also cannot lose sight of the fact that the matter stands settled. In the circumstances, this petition stands disposed of. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the court on or before 29.05.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 31.05.2019.

Since the main case has been disposed of, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
