Report dated 12.10.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hisar has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent No.2-Varsha and petitioner-Sachin, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, during the course of interaction with the parties, they have shown their resolve to end the dispute and have made statements that they have compromised the matter as per Annexure P-2 and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

The petition stands allowed in those terms. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the petitioner has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '*Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '*Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another*' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.331 dated 25.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 406, 498-A and 506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Hisar Sadar, District Hisar and all consequences arising out of the said FIR *qua* the petitioner are quashed.

The present petition stands disposed off.
