AMIT RAWAL, J.

Petitioner has sought quashing of the order dated 26.02.2019 (Annexure P-1) transferring her from CHC Badli, District Jhajjar to PHC Pingwa, Mewat and in response thereof, submitted a representation (Annexure P-2) raising objection on account of her husband suffering from paralysis.

This Court vide order dated 02.05.2019 issued notice of motion without any interim order.

Contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that she remained posted in Badli since 13.07.2016.

I am afraid, the aforementioned argument would not be sustainable in raising the objection qua transfer as place of posting prior to transfer had been almost close to three years. Person cannot be permitted to stay for that period under general transfers. Moreover, in the absence of any interim order, there is no assertion or argument that the petitioner has not

joined. The order cannot be said to be fallacious.

No ground for interference is made out. Resultantly, the writ petition is dismissed.
