Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the amount has been segregated, i.e. Rs. 10,00,000/- plus interest thereon as awarded by this Court. However, there is procedural difficulty as there are five petitioners, some of them are majors and some are minors. He further states that separate cheques for the major petitioners would be prepared and for minor petitioners, cheques would be prepared in the name of their mothers. Petitioners can collect their cheques from the office of Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Sangrur on 05.11.2019 at 11.00 AM by proving their identity through PAN Card or Adhaar Card.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondent in Court today, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.
