FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Amritpal Singh in case bearing FIR No.97 dated 29.06.2018 registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 12.09.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from HC Nirmal Singh who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner and the complainant are residing together after the compromise has been effected.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.09.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
