This is third bail application filed in FIR No. 84 dated 09.09.2015 registered under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Sections 4 and 5 of Chit and Money Circulation Scheme (Banning) Act, 1978 at Police Station Tapa Mandi, District Barnala.

In the order dated 27.02.2019, the learned trial Court has recorded that in the present case, 27 witnesses have been examined and only 2-3 witnesses remain to be examined.

Considering the fact that the trial is at the fag end, the Court is not inclined to entertain the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed.

Keeping in view period of incarceration of the petitioner, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
