INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 239 dated 26.05.2018, registered at Police Station Kundli, Sonapat, District Sonapat, under Sections 323, 307, 506, 120-B and 216 read with Section 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is named in the FIR and stated to be armed with pistol. As per the allegations, he fired two shots from the pistol, but the same did not hit anybody. In the

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present case, no injury has been declared dangerous to life, rather only injury is stated to have been given with wooden stick by co-accused which is simple one.

The petitioner has been in custody since 20.06.2018. Challan has already been presented. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
