The petitioner, driver of a truck, is in the revision petition against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence passed under Section 279, 304-A of the Indian Penal Code which has been affirmed in appeal.

The deceased was travelling on a scooter. The accident took place on 16.12.2002. The petitioner has already suffered protracted litigation for a period of 17 years. He was released on bail after having undergone actual custody of 4 months and 6 days on 14.12.2009. The petitioner is a first time offender.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the sentence awarded to the petitioner is reduced to the period already undergone.

Accordingly, the revision petition is disposed of.
