In pursuance to the last order dated 20.5.2019, learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of an affidavit of Sanjeev Kumar, Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4.

It is submitted that statement of the mother and the other heirs has been recorded and they have informed that they are not willing to get OPDs for Open Heart Surgery of mother of the petitioner. Therefore, the ground that the mother requires Open Heart Surgery is no more available to the petitioner.

Reply filed by the State shows that the petitioner is a convict in 13 cases for the offences of grievous nature. Some of which are very serious. Petitioner has been acquitted in 28 cases, ranged from minor to major offences of murder.

Considering the background of the petitioner and the fact that the mother of the petitioner does not require medical treatment as claimed by the petitioner, there is no ground to release the petitioner on parole. There is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned order dated 17.4.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad.

Dismissed.
