These three petitions have been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C

for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.44 dated 5.4.2018 registered under Sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 471, 120-B IPC read with Section 13 (1) (d) and 13 (2) P.C.Act, 1988 at police station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar.

The allegation against the petitioners (who were all the public servants) is that they colluded with private millers who defrauded the State by giving wrong physical verification.

Counsel for the petitioners have stated that the petitioners have been in custody for more than 8 months.

Learned DAG on instructions from DSP Tejinder Pal Singh has accepted that the petitioners have been in custody for more than 8 months.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioners, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioners. Ordered accordingly, Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petitions stand allowed.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
