Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to decide the representation dated 26.03.2019 filed by the petitioner against respondents No.4 & 5 for causing loss to the Govt. property.

A perusal of the petition as well as the complaint (Annexure P-1) shows that nothing is stated in the petition that the petitioner, who was an employee of Post Office, has given any complaint highlighting the incident of respondents No.4 & 5, rather learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly conceded that for this incidence, the petitioner was held guilty and his services were terminated by the Department.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
