The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.5 dated 10.01.2018 under Sections 307, 452, 148, 149, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner has been attributed gun shot injuries but they are on the non-vital part of the body.

Learned State counsel states that 6 out of 29 prosecution witnesses have been examined and the matter is listed for 19.07.2019 and efforts have been made to expedite the trial at this stage. She also contends that the petitioner had injured 5 persons with his revolver which included a lady.

Heard.

In view of the seriousness of the allegation against the petitioner that he had caused firearm injuries on five persons which included a lady, I do not find it appropriate to grant him regular bail and the petition stands dismissed.
