FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Sahil Gupta in case bearing FIR No.272 dated 18.07.2018 registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) under Sections 362, 366 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 13.09.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurrmail Singh, Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier together with the fact that the wife of the complainant has filed a duly sworn affidavit (Annexure P1) having renounced her relationship with the present complainant, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.09.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
