AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 18.9.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M No. 41096 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representations dated 3.8.2018 (Annexure P3) and 7.8.2018 (Annexure P4) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is found necessary, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Short reply dated 8.7.2019 by way of an affidavit of Saurabh Singh, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Panchkula was filed stating therein that representations of the petitioner have been rejected. Copy of the enquiry report has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner today

in Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, liberty is sought to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the said enquiry report.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
