Case called out. No one appears on behalf of the petitioners to press this petition. However, with the aid and assistance of Mr. Deepak Balyan, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, we have perused the record.

Petition has been filed challenging the notification dated 28.02.1997, issued under the Punjab Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1958, whereby registration as well as renewal fee of Rs.10,000/- has been imposed on the petrol pumps. The same notification was challenged by medical practitioners, who were running nursing homes, by filing CWP No.5672 of 2008 (**Dr. Satish Kumar Gupta etc. v. State of Haryana and others**), which came to be dismissed by a detailed judgment and order dated 04.04.2008. Following the said judgment, another writ petition bearing CWP No.16285 of 1997 filed by the Haryana Petroleum Dealers Association (Regd.) also came to be dismissed vide order dated 02.02.2011.

The issue raised in this petition stands squarely covered by the judgment rendered by this Court in Dr. Satish Kumar Gupta’s case (supra).

Following the ratio of the aforesaid judgment, this writ petition also stands dismissed.
