Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0230 dated 16.03.2019, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Panipat City, District Panipat.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 29.04.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that the petitioners already stand acquitted in the complaint case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and reference is made to order dated 27.03.2019 (P-4).

Notice of motion for 15.07.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to

interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contends that in terms of above order, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Saroj Kumar, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 29.04.2019, petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 29.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioners shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
