Petitioners Narender Sharma and Vandna Devi @ Vandna have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 and 5, who are mother and brother of petitioner No.2. Petitioner No.1 has annexed copy of his their Aadhar Card as well as petitioner No.2 has annexed copy of her voter identity card indicating that they are aged 33 years and 29 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

It may here be mentioned that petitioner No.1 is stated to have already been married to one Neetu Sharma in the year 2010 but the said marriage is stated to have been dissolved by decree of divorce passed by the Hon'ble Court of Ms. Jatinder Kaur, Additional District Judge, Patiala on 30.5.2018.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Panchkula, Haryana to look into the representation Annexure P-5 made by petitioner No.1, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not be taken to be an expression as regards validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.

A copy of this order be furnished to the petitioners under signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court today itself.
