The claim of the petitioner in the present writ petition is that his father, who was working with respondent No.4 as Mali, unfortunately, died while in service on 24.06.2017 after rendering approximately 37 years of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no benefit has been extended to the petitioner in respect of the service rendered by the late father of the petitioner despite the fact that approximately two years are going to elapse since the father of the petitioner died on 24.06.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 26.02.2019 (Annexure P-1), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the

respondents to decide the legal notice by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 26.02.2019 (Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
