Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for quashing the Kalandra under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C (P-21) and
arrest memo dated 22.06.2017 (P-22 and P-23).

Short reply by way of affidavit of Waryam Singh, PPS,
Assistant Commissioner of Police (Central), Ludhiana was filed in the
Registry on behalf of respondents No. 1,3 and 14/State. The same is
taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

At the very outset, learned State counsel on instructions
from ASI Gurmeet Singh, has apprised the Court that Kalandra in
question stands closed and both the petitioners alongwith four others
were directed to execute the bonds for good behaviour for six months

before the Executive Magistrate, Ludhiana vide order dated 06.10.2017 and that period has already elapsed.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter and the same is disposed off as such.

It is clarified that if the occasion so arises, the petitioners would be at liberty to approach this Court again.
