The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 07.01.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 40370 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Without going into the merits of the prayer made in the instant petition, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to file a comprehensive representation to respondent No.1 as regards their prayer/grievance. In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred, respondent No.1 i.e. the Registrar, Guru Nanak Dev University would be obligated to consider the same and to take a final decision thereupon in accordance with law within a period of 8 weeks from the date of submission of such representation.”

Ms. Isha Goyal, Advocate appears on behalf of the respondent and states that there were procedural glitches in deciding the representation.

The legal opinion has been sought and a speaking order would be passed on

the representation dated 16.01.2019 within two months from today.

In view of the statement made today in Court, the contempt petition is disposed of. In case, the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent today in Court is not adhered to, the petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
