In the present petition, petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.4 dated 06.04.2016 under Sections 409, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13 (1) (d) read with Section 13 (2) of PC Act, 1988, registered at Police Station V.B. Phase I, Mohali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

2 This Court vide order dated 08.05.2019 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3 Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Gurdev Singh, Police Station V.B. Phase I, Mohali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali states that in pursuance of the order dated 08.05.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and that he is not required for further custodial interrogation.

4 In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 08.05.2019, granting pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5 However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6 Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
