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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No. 21, dated 28.9.2018, registered at Police Station NRI, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420, 506 IPC (Sections 376 and 389 IPC added later on).
2. Vide order dated 28.5.2019, the petitioner had been granted interim bail to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Officer subject to his keeping good behaviour and not to extend any threat to the

prosecutrix. However, the learned counsel for the petitioner has today submitted that he is not in touch with the petitioner ever since the last date.

3. Learned State counsel has informed that despite specific directions, the petitioner has never approached the Investigating Officer and never furnished any bail bonds.
4. Keeping in view of the aforesaid position, it appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing this petition as he has even not chosen to furnish the interim bail bonds. The petition, as such, is dismissed.
