The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.107 dated 21.8.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366-A of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sadar, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of the order passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda which transpires that Lakhwinder Singh is on interim bail and charges have been framed.

Learned State counsel states that earlier the name of the petitioner has not been surfaced in the FIR and has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. He further states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 27.9.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make herself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against her so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
