On 29.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Kamaljit Kumar and Kulwinder Kaur, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 9 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent Nos.4 to 9. They have placed on record photographs Annexures P-4 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 24.04.2019, Annexure P-5 to respondent No.2.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 07.05.2019.”

Counsel appearing for the State of Punjab, on instructions from HC Jai Gopal, has submitted that the private respondents have recorded their statements to the effect that they would not cause any harm to the petitioners and they will not interfere in their married life.

Counsel for the petitioners, on the basis of aforesaid stand taken by the State counsel, prays for permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
