Petitioner is working as PGT (Fine Arts) and is seeking direction to the respondents to give him the benefit of ante dated promotion with all consequential benefits keeping in view the letter dated 17/19.04.2017 (Annexure P-1), whereby 3% of the total number of posts in each cadre strength are to be reserved for persons with disabilities and clarification dated 23.01.2018 (Annexure P-2).

With regard to his grievance, petitioner has given a detailed representation dated 01.02.2019 (Annexure P-5) followed by legal notice dated 20.02.2019 (Annexure P-6), but no action has been taken thereon till date.

At this stage, instant petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.1 to look into the representation dated 01.02.2019 and legal notice dated 20.02.2019 (Annexures P-5 & P-6) and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It is further clarified that, if a

speaking order has already been passed on the legal notice dated 20.02.2019

(Annexure P-6), then only a short order be passed annexing the said detailed order.
