Learned counsel for the petitioner while referring to Annexure P-5 contends that though renewal of dealers and processors' license is for one year, but five times the prescribed fee is being charged by the Rubber Board.

From a bare perusal of Annexure P-5, the argument seems to be without any substance because the form itself specifies that renewal of the dealers and processors' license is from 2019 to 2024 and that is why the fee for five years has been charged.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner sought leave of the Court to permit withdrawal of this writ petition.

Prayer made is allowed .

Petition accordingly stands dismissed as withdrawn keeping the right reserved to the petitioner of filing a fresh petition in case the respondents charge fee more than the prescribed rate for renewal of the license for a period of one year.
