Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.356 dated 19.08.2016 under Sections 302 and 34 of IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station DLF-II, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Suresh Kumar, submits that the trial of the case is at the fag end. It is submitted that out of 16 witnesses, 12 witnesses have already been examined and the remaining prosecution witnesses are official witnesses; along with the complainant. It is further submitted that all these witnesses would be examined very soon and the prosecution evidence will be completed at the earliest possible.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere to grant bail to the petitioner. However, it is directed that the prosecution shall complete its entire evidence within next two months. Thereafter, the trial Court shall finally decide the case expeditiously.
