Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of the impugned order dated 19.10.2007 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender.

In view of the order dated 11.04.2019 passed in CRM-M-40536 of 2018, the compromise was effected between the parties and FIR No. 124 dated 27.07.2004, under Sections 323, 325, 295, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal

Code, registered at Police Station Dasuya, Hoshiarpur stands quashed qua the petitioner.

Since the matter has been settled and FIR stands quashed, the order dated 19.10.2007 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur is quashed qua the petitioner.
