CM is allowed. Reply annexed with the application is taken on record.

Main Petition

In pursuance to the order dated 27.8.2019, Dhirendra Kumar Tiwari, Chairman, Punjab State Board of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Chandigarh is present in Court and tenders an unconditional apology. He submits that the delay occurred as the person who had received the order had not forwarded the same even to the Administrative Branch and appropriate action is being taken against him, he has already been suspended.

With the reply filed, order dated 29.8.2019 has been annexed whereby the claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after rejection of the claim, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he states that the petitioner has suffered due to delay in deciding representation. He seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order dated 29.8.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
