Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.54 dated 12.02.2019 registered under Sections 381, 420, 34 IPC at Police Station City Palwal.

On 30.04.2019, following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion for 5.7.2019.

At this stage, Mr. Tushar Gautam, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and

cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

On 05.07.2019, when the case again came up for hearing, learned counsel for the State prayed that petitioner may be directed to give his specimen handwriting.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the aforesaid specimen handwriting has already been given.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and without commenting on the merits of the case, this Court is of the view that interim protection granted by this Court on 30.04.2019 is required to be confirmed in the facts and circumstances of the present case.

Hence, order dated 30.04.2019 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
