The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 273 dated 05.12.2011, under Sections 447, 427, 148, 149 and 150 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Nakodar, District Jalandhar as well as order dated 20.01.2016, vide which, the petitioner has been declared as a proclaimed person.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner confined his prayer only to the extent that the interim order dated 12.10.2018 be made absolute and he will not press for quashing of the FIR in question, rather will contest the trial.

The prayer seems to be justified and accepted. The petitioner has already joined the proceedings before learned trial Court in pursuance to the order dated 12.10.2018 of this Court, therefore, order dated 12.10.2018 is made absolute.

Needless to say that the petitioner will be at liberty to raise all his pleas before learned trial Court in accordance with law.

Learned Trial Court is requested to expedite the trial.
