Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 read with Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. is for setting aside of the order dated 12.04.2019 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga, whereby respondent No.2 Jaswinder Singh was admitted on anticipatory bail in FIR No.46 dated 01.03.2019 under Sections 376, 313 and 495 IPC registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Perusal of the FIR as well as impugned order dated 12.04.2019 shows that the complainant had been staying with respondent No.2 for about 9 years and it is thereafter, it was alleged that respondent No.2 performed a second marriage with the complainant without having divorce from his earlier wife. Since the complainant stayed with respondent No.2 for a period of about 9 years and thereafter, the FIR was registered against respondent No.2, this Court finds that no ground is made out to cancel the anticipatory bail granted

to respondent No.2 vide order dated 12.04.2019 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
