Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0128 dated 17.12.2018 registered for the offence under Section 380 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

As per the FIR, gold and silver ornaments were stolen from the house of complainant Mangat Ram by breaking open the window panes and almirah. The name of the present petitioner is also mentioned in the FIR.

The custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required in this case as some recovery is yet to be effected from her.

Keeping in view the above facts, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
