The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.71, dated 22.5.2018, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Sector 20, Panchkula.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that apart from other facts the petitioner has been in custody for about one year.

Custody certificate has been filed, as per which the petitioner has been in custody for 11 months and 28 days as on 25.5.2019.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
