The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.01 dated 27.03.2018, registered under Sections 498-A, 420, 406 IPC (Sections 420 and 406 IPC added later on), at Police Station NRI Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have also filed a petition i.e. CRM M-1268-2019 for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise which is still pending before this Court. He has also placed on record the order dated 14.01.2019, passed by this Court in the aforesaid petition.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dara Singh has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation; recovery has already been effected and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 20.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
